

# DO THE SAME

## THE GAME

You have to reproduce a picture by rotating a four squared tileset using your keyboard or joystick (see Controls part).  
The game have THE 112 levels of the Atari Jaguar version :)

## GAME MODES

You can choose between 3 difficulty levels :

- Get16 (EASY) > To complete this level, you have to resolve 16 stages. *You start with 2 Lives*
- More32 (NORMAL) > For this one, you have to resolve 32 stages BUT the timer is a little bit faster. *You start with 3 Lives*
- Roar64 (HARD) > For this last one, 64 levels await you with a faster timer and *4 Lives*.

## THE CONTROLS

You can play "Do The Same" by using

KEYBOARD >> R.E.C.O.M.M.A.N.D.E.D <<

Arrow keys : UP / DOWN / LEFT and RIGHT

X : rotating the squared tileset anti-clockwise

C : rotating the squared tileset clockwise

- 2 FIRE BUTTONS JOYSTICK /!\ Fire 1 & 2 are inverted /!\

UP / DOWN / LEFT and RIGHT

Fire 1 (or B): Rotating clockwise

Fire 2 (or A): Rotating anti-clockwise

- 1 FIRE BUTTON JOYSTICK

UP / DOWN / LEFT and RIGHT

Fire : Rotating clockwise

For each of these 3 methods, you can also use

R : to restart a level (you loose 20 pts and have a 5s penalty)

ESC : to quit the game and return to the menu

## EXTRA LIFE

You can win an extra life every 300 pts

## SCORE

The score depends of the time it tooks you to resolve a stage

## WEBSCORE

At the end of each stage, a small insert appears with the real time it tooks you and the number of moves you have made to resolve a stage.

At the end of each level, a new insert appears with the Total Time it tooks you to resolve a complete level and the total number of moves.

For both inserts, you'll have a webscore code (12 chars). You can enter this code on this website (WARNING : letters are in 'yellow' color and numbers are in 'light blue'color).
